

Q1: NIT Srinagar is affiliated to which University/Body?

NIT Srinagar is an Institute of National Importance and is an Autonomous Body under the Ministry of Education, GOI.

Q2 : Whether NIT Srinagar is a registered Institute?

Yes, NIT Srinagar is registered under Societies Act.

A3 : What are the different programmes offered by NIT Srinagar?

NIT Srinagar offers UG, PG and Research programs as under;

- 8 B.Tech. Programmes in eight disciplines of Engineering.
- 11 M.Tech. Programmes in Five Engineering Departments,
- MBA Programme
- MTIEM Programme
- MSc Physics & Chemistry Programme
- Ph.D. Programmes in all the Engineering, Sciences and Humanities Social Science & Management Departments.

4 Year full time Bachelor of Technology Degree Courses offered in:

1) Chemical Engineering	5) Electronics & Communication Engineering
2) Civil Engineering	6) Information Technology
3) Computer Science Engineering	7) Mechanical Engineering

Master of Technology (M.Tech) degree courses on full time & part- time basis offered in:

The duration of an M.Tech. Course is of two years (four semesters) for full time students & 3 years for those admitted under part-time. Part time enrolment is given only to sponsored candidates.

Q8: How can one take admission in Undergraduate programmes at NIT Srinagar?

One can take admission to the Undergraduate programmes at NIT Srinagar only through Central Seat Allocation Board (CSAB) after qualifying JEE (Main) examination of the same year. No other means of admission is available at NIT Srinagar.

Q9: How can one take admission in M.Tech programme at NIT Srinagar?

One can take admission to M.Tech programme through Common Counselling for M.Tech(CCMT) after qualifying GATE. If seats remain vacant after GATE qualified candidates, in some specific low popular Specializations, admission can be given to Non-GATE candidates.

Q10: What are the other Postgraduate programmes offered by NIT Srinagar?

Apart from M.Tech, NIT Srinagar offers Postgraduate programmes in M.Sc. (in Applied Geology, Chemistry, Life Science, Mathematics and physics), MBA and MA in Development Studies. All these are 2 years (4 semesters) programmes..

Q11: How can one take admission in MBA programme at NIT Srinagar?

Admission to MBA programme at NIT Srinagar is done through an open advertisement and Institutional selection process. Advertisement contains all details including selection process.

Q12 : After taking admission to a programme paying full fee if a student cancels his/her admission, how much money he/she will get back?

For the programmes for which admission is done through central bodies like CSAB (for UG), CCMT(for M.Tech), JAM (for 2 year M.Sc.) etc. , if a student cancels/ surrenders his/her admission before the last date for seat surrender for the last round of admission so that his/her seat can be included in the vacancy list, he/she will get back money after statutory deductions from the admission fee and the balance of Mess advance after adjustment of dues, if any

Q13: How are Exams conducted at the Institute?

NIT Srinagar follows a Credit based continuous Assessment System with one midterm & one major examination in each semester. All undergraduate, post graduate & Ph.D. Examinations, of the Institute are conducted centrally by the Examination Section of the Institute.

Q14: What is the medium of examination?

The medium of examination for all examinations including dissertations & thesis is British English

Q15: How is the performance of a student Evaluated?

The performance of a student is evaluated in terms of two indices viz; the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) for a semester & Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) which is the Grade point index for all the completed Semesters at any point of time. The Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) is calculated on the basis of grades obtained in all courses in a semester & Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is calculated on the basis of pass grade in all completed semesters.

For each course, a grade is awarded on the basis of two written examinations in the case of theory papers i.e. Mid-term & Major Examinations with weight-age of 30 & 60 marks, respectively. 10 marks are reserved for class performance & attendance of the student in the course. The paper setting & evaluation is done by the concerned Faculty Members of the respective Departments in the Common Evaluation Centre of the Institute. The award rolls are being uploaded on the ERP Portal by the concerned faculty member under the supervision of DUGC. Mid-Term examination answer scripts are returned to students & major answer scripts are shown to them before submission of grades to the DUGC.

B. Tech. students are required to submit a project report of their project at the end of the 8th semester, which starts in 7th semester. It is to be submitted in the form of a bound thesis. The Heads of the Departments constitute a Project Evaluation Board (PEB) which assesses each individual project of the students. The evaluation is done in the following manner:-

Q16: Who sits on the Project Evaluation Board?

The Project Evaluation Board comprises of:-

- Head of the Department concerned
- One senior most faculty member of the concerned department
- Supervisor concerned &
- One expert from any other sister Department of the Institute for B.Tech.

In case of M.Tech the expert is from outside the Institute, nominated by Director from an approved panel.

Q17: When does an Academic Session Begin at NIT Srinagar?

The academic session is divided into two semesters, an autumn semester (August–December) & a spring semester (March–July). The Semester system is enforced at both under-graduate (U.G.) & post graduate (P.G.) levels.

Q18: How many days in a week are classes conducted?

NIT Srinagar follows 5 days week period with at least 90 working days in each semester. Weekdays used for E.C.A. & other such activities.
