This is to inform all the faculty members of the Institute and UG/PG/PhD. students of NIT Srinagar that from spring session 2023 and onwards


As Per SUGC Resolution -11/09 that was ratified in the 32 senate applicable for all UG Courses:

- i) The continuous assessment of any course will be of 24 marks with 8 marks for Assignment/Tutorial, 8 marks for Quiz/GD/Seminar & 8 marks for class response/Attendance.
- ii) The Mid Term Examination will be of 26 marks and question paper will be of 1 hour & 15 minutes duration, having 2 compulsory questions of equal weightage with no internal and/or external choice for questions.
- iii) The End Term Examination will be of 50 marks and question paper will be of 2 hours and 30 minutes duration with four questions having internal choice for any one question only and weightage of each question will be 10-15 marks.

The question paper of Mid-Term and End-Term should necessarily be embedded with course outcomes of the concerned Subject.

As approved by the competent authority applicable for all PG and/or PhD. Courses

- i) The continuous assessment of any course will be of 24 marks with 8 marks for Assignment/Tutorial, 8 marks for Quiz/GD/Seminar & 8 marks for class response/Attendance.
- ii) The Mid Term Examination will be of 26 marks and question paper will be of 1 hour & 15 minutes duration, having 2 compulsory questions of equal weightage with no internal and/or external choice for questions.
- iii) The End Term Examination will be of 50 marks and question paper will be of 2 hours and 30 minutes duration with four compulsory questions and weightage of each question will be 10-15 marks and there should not be any internal and/or external choice for questions.
